Negotiation over free trade

The tenth round of negotiations towards a Canada-India Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement (CEPA) is all set to be held in New Delhi next year. Both the countries would be focusing to come up with suggestion to enhance trade relations between the two countries.

A joint study group comprised of Canadian and Indian officials would be working for the purpose. Under Canada's Global Commerce Strategy, the government is working to advance Canada's trade interests by opening up opportunities for Canada's exporters. This will

be providing new gateway of opportunities. Export would become cheaper and easier and exporters would be able to provide the goods at much better prices as compared to now.

Now one of the fastest growing economies on the planet, India is projected to be World's third largest economy by 2050. Progress has been made in all areas including market access for goods,

rules of origin, trade facilitations, origin procedures, technical barriers to trade, institutional provisions and trade in services including temporary entry of



business persons. The CEPA negotiations remain a key priority in Government of Canada's International trade agenda.
